

Your Recycling and Bulky Waste Clean-Up Guide



Your booked Bulky Waste Clean-Up

If you have large unwanted items you can't sell or give away, you can book a Bulky Waste Clean-Up service for Council to dispose of them. This service is for items that are too large to fit in the bin.

For most unit blocks, you will need your strata manager or building caretaker to book the Clean-Up.

Contact your building's caretaker or strata manager who will make a booking on behalf of the whole building.

Put the date in your diary and remember to place your items out the night before.

Follow the building manager's instructions for where and when to put your items out for collection.

Your yellow recycling bins

Your yellow bin is only for the household items shown here. Waste from your bin is taken to a recovery facility where people and machines sort the paper, metal, glass and plastic into separate categories. These are then taken to recycling plants and made into new products.

Remember to place items loosely into the recycling bin. Keeping them out of plastic bags is the best way to ensure they get recycled.

Accepted items



Plastic bottles, tubs and containers



Paper and cardboard



Glass bottles and jars



Aluminium, steel and aerosol cans

When you tip your recycling in loose, rather than in a plastic bag, you know that it gets recycled.



Beyond your yellow bin

Your yellow bin is for paper and packaging you use at home. You can take other materials such as soft plastic, electronics, chemicals and much more to special drop-off locations for recycling or safe disposal. Separating these items and dropping them off for recycling helps you reduce waste.
