

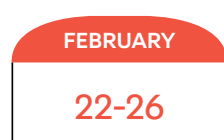
Get ready for changes to your waste and recycling service.

Dear Resident,

The City of Canterbury Bankstown is working to provide you with the most efficient and streamlined waste service. In order to do so, your waste and recycling service will undergo a few changes over the coming weeks.

These changes are the final stage of Council's realignment of waste services between the former Canterbury and Bankstown local government areas. Council will continue its role in bringing the future of smart collections, recycling and reusing, resource recovery and waste minimisation to all generations across the City.

We're making bin collections more efficient for you.
Here's what you need to know and when:



Put all three bins out on your normal collection day on the week commencing Monday 22 February. To ensure no one has overflowing bins, we will be doing a **special one-off collection** for all three bins on the week commencing Monday 22 February.



Red bin days are changing for most households across the City from the week commencing Monday 1 March.



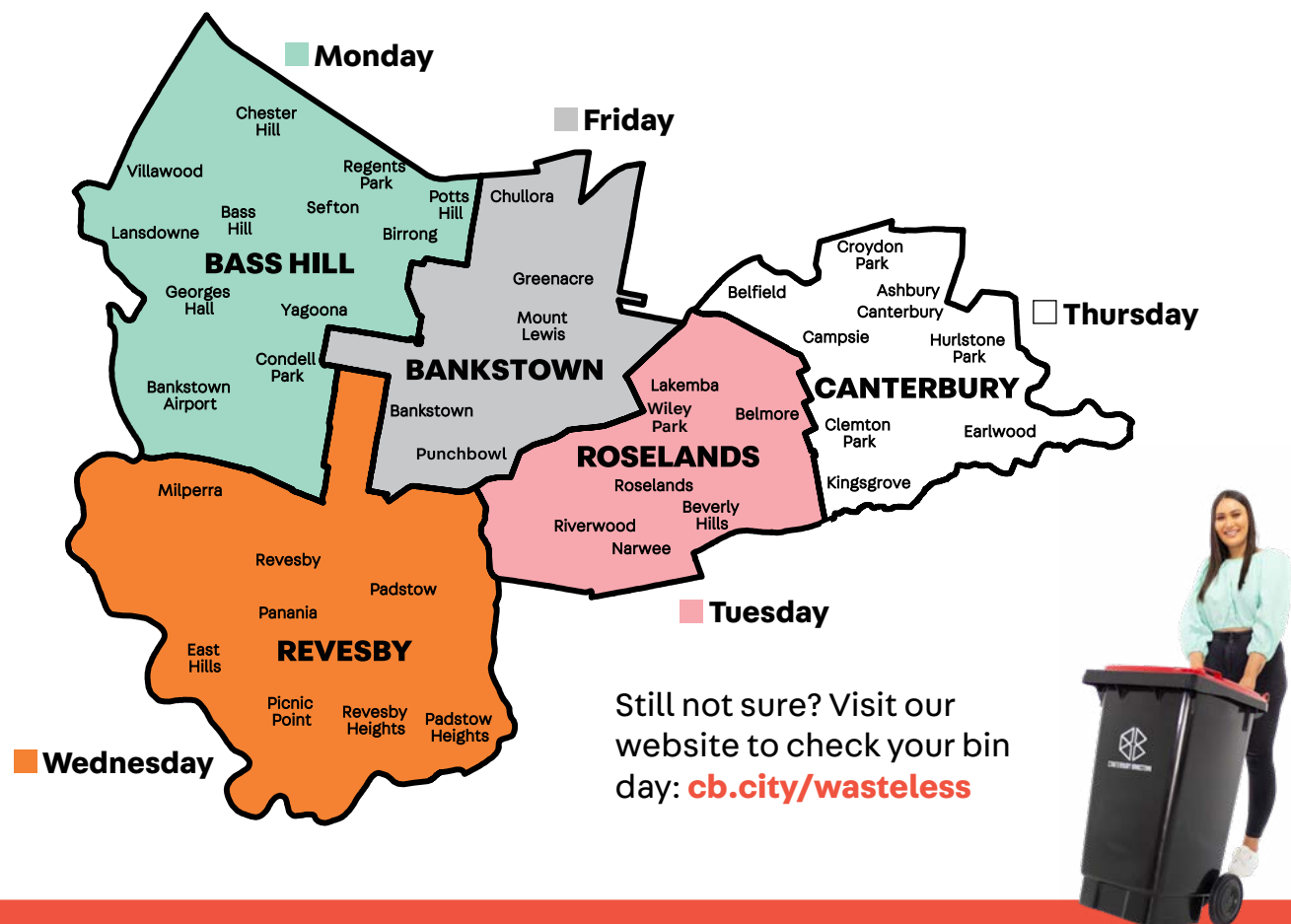
New yellow and green bin days. They will be collected the same day as your red bin but the fortnightly cycle may change.

Bin days are moving

Your bin collection day may change. Starting from the week of 1-5 March, collection days across the City will be based on the five Council wards. View the below list and map to find out if your bin day is changing. Remember some suburbs are split by a main road. These areas may have two different collection days.



| Collection Day | Ward | Suburbs |
|----------------|------------|---|
| Monday | Bass Hill | Bass Hill, Birrong, Chester Hill, Condell Park, Georges Hall, Lansdowne, Potts Hill, Regents Park, Sefton, Villawood and Yagoona. |
| Tuesday | Roselands | Belmore, Beverly Hills, Kingsgrove, Lakemba, Narwee, Punchbowl, Riverwood, Roselands and Wiley Park. |
| Wednesday | Revesby | East Hills, Milperra, Padstow, Padstow Heights, Panania, Picnic Point, Revesby and Revesby Heights. |
| Thursday | Canterbury | Ashbury, Belfield, Campsie, Canterbury, Clemton Park, Croydon Park, Earlowood, Hurlstone Park and Kingsgrove. |
| Friday | Bankstown | Bankstown, Chullora, Condell Park, Greenacre, Mount Lewis, Punchbowl and Yagoona. |

New collection times

With new routes, trucks and drivers, collection times will change for many households. They may be earlier, or they may be later. Please ensure you put your bin out the night before, so you do not miss your collection day.

Bulky Waste Clean-Up changes

From the first week in March there will be some changes to the Bulky Waste Clean-Up service. These changes are designed to reduce waiting times, improve customer service and increase the environmental benefits of the program. For example, Council's new trucks will allow fridges and air-conditioners to be separated and transported to a facility where the refrigerants can be safely removed, and mattresses will be picked up by a separate recycler.

The specific changes include:

- All households will be able to put out three square metres (3m²) of waste for collection (that is a pile one metre tall and three metres long). This is an increase for many households;
- For unit or apartment blocks with six (6) or more households, booking will need to be made by a caretaker, building manager or the strata on behalf of the whole building;
- The phasing in of separate collections for items such as mattresses, will enable Council to recycle much more; and
- Improvements to Council's online booking system.

What you can do

- Keep an eye on your letterbox and your bin as Council will be sending out more information; and
- Share updates with your friends, family and neighbours so they know changes are coming too.
